Mopar Club SD couldn't hold its annual All American Car Show this year, due to the pandemic, but club members and other car aficionados still made it possible for the club to donate \$6,000 to Wounded Warrior Homes and Fleet Week San Diego.

Fleet Week San Diego, which also received \$3,000, supports active-duty military and veterans through a week-long celebration that this year is planned for Nov. 7-15 at the Broadway Pier downtown. When this year's All American Car Show had to be canceled, the Mopar Club offered refunds to those who had already registered for the event and to trophy and show sponsors; however, the majority requested that the club instead donate those funds to the show's two beneficiaries. In addition, many individual MCSO members made donations, and the club held a "Freak Out Cruise" at JBA Speed Shop, drawing several hundred participants in classic and muscle cars who also donated funds for WWH and Fleet Week. Also, almost 300 pounds of canned goods were donated for the Wounded Warrior Homes' pantry. MCSO President Jeff Walker said, "The pandemic put the brakes on our annual car show, but our show beneficiaries needed our help more than ever during this crisis. Thank you to all who made it possible for us to raise \$6,000 for them."
